Our eMAR was created in response to a clear market gap: existing eMAR solutions were not built for real-world clinical workflows and they were rigid, difficult to use, and poorly aligned with how care teams actually work. Our eMAR is unified within our platform and prioritizes usability, configurability, and compliance. The result is a role-based medication administration record system clinicians can trust, adopt quickly, and rely on daily.

Core Medication Administration Capabilities

Medication administration serves as the central hub for medication scheduling, administration, and documentation. Prescriptions written within our ePrescribing and EPCS tools flow directly into our eMAR, where medications are automatically scheduled and displayed on a real time dashboard. Clinical staff can instantly see what medications are due, overdue, completed, or unresolved—supporting safe handoffs and continuity of care across shifts.

Supported medication statuses

include Pending, Administered, Refused, Missed, and Skipped, ensuring complete visibility into patient medication adherence.

Bed Management & Census Control

If you offer inpatient services, our eMAR includes built in bed management and census tracking to support daily operations.

You can easily track:

- Patient room and bed assignments
- Admission, transfer, and discharge activity
- Staff responsible for admits and discharges

Patient and prescriber data remain managed within our EHR, while the eMAR feature handles real time facility logistics and patient location management.

Automated Medication Dispensing

Our electronic medication administration record integrates directly with medication dispensing devices, making it ideal for behavioral health, substance use disorder, and methadone treatment centers. Patients can:

- Check in to a waiting area or kiosk
- Be routed to the correct window or dispensing location
- Receive medication automatically from connected dispensing machines

Inventory levels update in real time, eliminating manual entry and reducing dispensing errors.



Medication Inventory Management

Our MAR provides accurate, real time medication inventory tracking at both the facility and patient level. Automation records medications received, dispensed, transferred, returned, lost, or reconciled—supporting controlled substance accountability and shift change verification. Dual witness verification and complete audit trails can help you reduce diversion risk and maintain regulatory compliance.

Methadone & SUD specific Medication Workflows

Our electronic medication administration record is purpose built to support methadone and SUD medication workflows:

- Direct integration with methadone dispensing machines
- Bottle level inventory tracking
- Take home dose management with DEA compliant labeling
- Central Registry aligned reporting for SUD programs

These workflows are designed to support federal, state, and program level compliance requirements.

DEA compliant Reporting & Audit Readiness

Our eMAR includes robust reporting tools built to support DEA compliance and audit readiness.

Available reports include:

- Medication administration histories
- Controlled substance inventory and reconciliation
- Methadone and SUD specific reports
- MAR calendars and physician order documentation

Reports can be customized, scheduled, and exported as PDFs or spreadsheets for internal review or external audits.

Patient Observation, Vitals & Nutrition Tracking

Beyond medication delivery, our eMAR supports comprehensive patient monitoring:

- Scheduled patient observations with configurable locations and activities
- Vitals documentation with historical trend views
- Food and nutrition intake tracking

Automated alerts notify staff when required observations or checks are missed, supporting physician orders and regulatory mandates.

Intelligent Messaging & Compliance Alerts

Built in messaging ensures critical events never go unnoticed. The medication administration record tools automatically trigger alerts when patients:

- Miss or refuse medications
- Miss appointments or required check ins
- Require follow up for compliance or care coordination
